

Ambleside & Bowness

A mile inland from the northern tip of Windermere lakeshore, Ambleside is a bustling town of outdoor equipment shops, bookshops, gift shops, cafes and restaurants. Nestled in the valley between various fells, it's the start and end point for many classic lake land walks. The Lake District's most popular destination, Bowness-on-Windermere is busy for most of the year. People come to enjoy the lake for sailing and water sports or just relax and enjoy the atmosphere of the area and the towns delightful setting.



Beamish (Including Admission)

An early start this morning as we make our way north to Beamish where we spend the day. Beamish is a world-famous open-air museum, telling the story of life in North East England during the 1820's, 1900's and 1940's. Highlights include 1900s Town, 1900s Pit Village, 1940s Farm and Rowley Station. Step 'behind the scenes' into the Open Store and see some fascinating objects stored in the collections. Get a real taste of the past, catering outlets across the site serve traditional tasty treats, from homemade hot meals to delicious snacks, cakes and drinks.



Beaumaris

Take a walk through the town, starting with a stroll along the sea-front, taking in the pier and the views over the Menai Strait and Snowdonia, then continuing through charming streets with their picturesque cottages. Beaumaris has lively cafes, pubs and restaurants and some excellent shopping marked by quality independent traders.



Beverley Market

With it's awe-inspiring Minster, historical buildings, cobbled streets and small town charm there is something for everyone in Beverley. An up-market shopping experience amongst cobbled streets and courtyards with many high street names. In addition there is an interesting selection of smaller independent shops, an antique arcade and the Saturday Market is delightful for a weekend browse.



Boundary, Banny's & Illuminations

First stop today is Boundary Outlet for a spot of retail therapy . Grab a big-name brand at a bargain price before heading off to Banny's Fish & Chip Restaurant where we enjoy a delicious 'Chippy Tea' before we head to Blackpool. Blackpool Illuminations see the seaside city of fun still buzzing with excitement and laughter long after other resorts have gone into winter hibernation. At 10 kilometres long and using over one million bulbs, the Blackpool Illuminations are an awesome spectacle.





Cadbury World (Including Admission)

Explore the different zones of this fascinating attraction and learn the story of Cadbury Chocolate. Highlights include 4D Chocolate Adventure – a 4D cinema experience complete with motion seats. Bull Street – a full scale replica of the original street where John Cadbury opened his shop in 1824. Cadabra – Cadbury World's very own ride – a magical journey full of surprises, and Advertising Avenue take a trip down memory lane and see how many Cadbury Ads you remember. There will be little chocolate treats along the way.



Carlisle

The largest city in England by area, Carlisle lies in the far northern corner of England, near the Scottish border, and is the urban capital of Cumbria and the beating heart of the Borderlands. Explore dungeons and labyrinths at Carlisle's medieval castle, 900 -year-old cathedral and Cumbria's Museum of Military Life, all housed within the city's Historic Quarter.



Chester Zoo, Chester or Cheshire Oaks

We journey to Chester where you choose your destination. With over 15,000 animals in 125 acres of award-winning zoological gardens there is plenty to keep you busy for the day. For those not wanting to visit the Zoo, our coach will continue to Cheshire Oaks for the ultimate shopping experience and then continue to the Roman city of Chester for free time. It's up to you where you spend the day.




Cleveleys

Matlock Bath

Manchester Ship Canal (Including Fare)



Pickering & Helmsley

We also visit Helmsley, a perfect English market town, with dramatic castle ruins, charming tea rooms and inviting inns.



Portmeirion (Includes Admission)

Portmeirion Village is well known as the location for the 1960s cult TV series The Prisoner. It comprises a cluster of colour-washed buildings around a central piazza, scenic surroundings and extensive woodlands. In addition to its architectural heritage, its stunning setting and sub-tropical gardens, Portmeirion has two stylish hotels, shops, a spa, cafes and restaurants and an authentic Italian style gelateria.



Rail, Sail & Tails (Includes Fares and Admission)

This great trip combines a ride on a steam train, one way from Haverthwaite to Lakeside. A single cruise from Lakeside to Bowness with free time in Bowness to explore until our 2:30pm entrance into the world-famous The World of Beatrix Potter – the English author and illustrator who is best known for her imaginative children's books, the most famous of all being the Tale of Peter Rabbit.



Ripon

The little city that packs a big punch, Ripon, in Yorkshire is a cathedral city steeped in history and home to magnificent historical buildings and long observed traditions. You will find a trio of award-winning museums and a gothic cathedral that dates back to the 7th century that are waiting to feed our enquiring minds. With a thriving market place, this busy little city will earn a place in any visitor's heart. Reaching out from the market square are small streets and snickets that are home to eclectic and specialist shops for which Ripon is so loved. Amongst them are cafes and pubs, offering refreshment and home cooked food throughout the day.


Whitby


Chatsworth House at Christmas (Including Admission)


